- Develop and implement systems of work that are safe and without risk so far as reasonably practicable
- Provide premises that are safe and without risk to health
- Provide and maintain equipment and substances appropriate for business operations and activities
- Provide adequate information, instruction, training and supervision to employees
- Provide adequate facilities for the welfare of workers

We are committed to ensuring that our documented systems are implemented, complied with and reviewed as per our legislative requirements and meet the criteria of AS/NZS 4801 Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems.

Monitoring and reviewing performance indicators on a monthly basis enables the company to measure the progressiveness of our occupational health and safety management. Regular audits shall be undertaken to ensure our systems meet legal compliance and standards adopted by the Company and areas for improvement are identified and rectified accordingly.
